

Reasons to Circumcise

Parents who choose circumcision do so based on religious beliefs, concerns about hygiene, as well as cultural and social reasons.

Medical reasons include:

- Lower risk of penile cancer,
- Decreased risk of transmission of sexually transmitted diseases,
- As well as lower risk of penile problems such as irritation, inflammation and infection.



Cost


Elective newborn circumcisions are not covered by OHIP. Circumcisions are done at both the Northern Urology Centre (NUC) and Health Sciences North (HSN). Price, including hst, is \$450. If you choose to have the circumcision done at HSN, the hospital will charge an additional fee.

Preparation & Requirements

Ideally the baby should be less than 10lbs and under 1 month old. Please call the NUC as soon as possible after delivery to book. No referral is necessary!

Day of the Procedure

Please ensure that your baby is well fed and dressed in a one-piece sleeper, if available. Also bring diapers, wipes and a soother if one is available. Arrive at the NUC at the time of your appointment. Dr. Bora and his team will carry out the circumcision at the first appointment, barring any issues. The total visit should be less than one hour. Post procedure instructions will be supplied at the procedure.

What is Circumcision?

A circumcision is a surgical procedure to remove the layer of skin that covers the head of the penis (foreskin) and part of the shaft. This procedure is most often done during the first days after birth.
